

Asthma 411 Spring 2023 Challenge Grant!

Deadline for Submission: December 15th, 2022

Project Overview: Up to \$2,000.00 will be awarded to individual schools or school districts to pilot an intervention to strengthen school asthma services.

Proposal Submission:

- Please provide all information listed on the next page
- Please include a letter of support from your school administrator on official letterhead
- Email your proposal and letter of support to Asthma411.unthsc.edu

Timeline:

- October 14th 2022: Announcement
- December 15th: *Deadline for submission*
- January 15th: Winners announced and preparation
- February through April 15th, 2023: *Project implementation*
- May 15th, 2023: *Reports submitted*

Support: Asthma 411 staff will provide support during project implementation and reporting.

Criteria for Selection: Proposals should:

- Align with best practice recommendations outlined in National School -based Asthma Management. Program (<u>SAMPRO</u>) or ALA's Asthma Friendly School Initiative (<u>AFSI</u>).
- Define the specific objectives and actions of the project.
- Be achievable to pilot within the proposal the timeframe.
- Have a measurable outcome for your objectives that will be included in your final report.
- Include all items specified on page two.

Projects Categories: There are four project categories with examples listed below.

- 1. Maximizing School Health Services
 - Assess students reported to have asthma and identify those who may be at highest risk. (*ex. Date of most recent Primary Care or Asthma Specialist visit, hospitalization or ED visits within the past year, course of oral steroids in the past year.*
 - Assess students with indications of poor or deteriorating control using the Asthma Control Test. (use of standing delegation orders, using quick-relief medication more than 2X per week, elevated absences.
- 2. Asthma Education
 - Implement programs for students, families, coaches, teachers, or other school staff
- 3. <u>Healthy School Environments</u>
 - Address potential environmental triggers using nationally recommended tools adapted for your school.
